


NOTICE OF SUBMISSION TRANSPORTATION ENVIRONMENTAL STUDY REPORT ADDENDUM

HIGHWAY 401 IMPROVEMENTS FROM HIGHWAY 410/403 INTERCHANGE TO EAST OF THE CREDIT RIVER REGION OF PEEL, CITY OF MISSISSAUGA (G.W.P. 2149-01-00) AND (G.W.P. 2150-01-00)

THE PROJECT

In compliance with the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario's ("MTO") Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities (2000) ("Class EA"), a Transportation Environmental Study Report (TESR) for proposed improvements to Highway 401 from Highway 410/403 interchange to east of the Credit River (G.W.P. 2149-01-00 and G.W.P. 2150-01-00) was filed in the Public Record in August 2005. The TESR was submitted to document the proposed transportation engineering and environmental protection plan at a Preliminary Design level of detail



Since that time, MTO has commenced the Detail Design of the proposed Highway 401 improvements under G.W.P. 2150-01-00, which will complete the expansion of Highway 401 within the project limits from its current 6 lanes to a 12-lane core/collector system. Through discussions with the City of Mississauga, it was requested to have the MTO study the need for a future extension of Belgrave Road from the Highway 401 eastbound off ramp at Mavis Road easterly to the existing cul-de-sac west of Suffolk Court – a distance of approximately 200m, as shown on the Key Plan. The extension will provide a future direct connection to Mavis Road, thereby improving traffic service to commercial and industrial areas to the east.

Consistent with the Class EA, a TESR Addendum has been prepared to document and amend the design changes and associated environmental impacts to accommodate both the Highway 401 widening and the extension of Belgrave Road.

THE PROCESS

This project is being conducted as a Group "B" undertaking in compliance with the *Class Environmental Assessment (EA) for Provincial Transportation Facilities* (2000). An Addendum has been prepared to document the design modifications described above to the previously approved TESR. Consultation with interested and affected parties has taken place and is documented in the Addendum.

The TESR Addendum has been placed on the Public Record for a formal review period of 30 calendar days between the dates of **June 10, 2015** and **July 10, 2015**. A copy of the Addendum has been submitted to the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change and is available for review at the following locations:

Since the preliminary design of this project has already been approved under the requirements of the Class EA, opportunities for requesting a Part II Order are only applicable to the changes documented in the Addendum. A copy of a Part II Order request should be forwarded to MTO and AECOM Canada Limited at the addresses below. If there are no outstanding concerns after **July 10**, **2015**, the project will be considered to have met the requirements of the Class EA.
